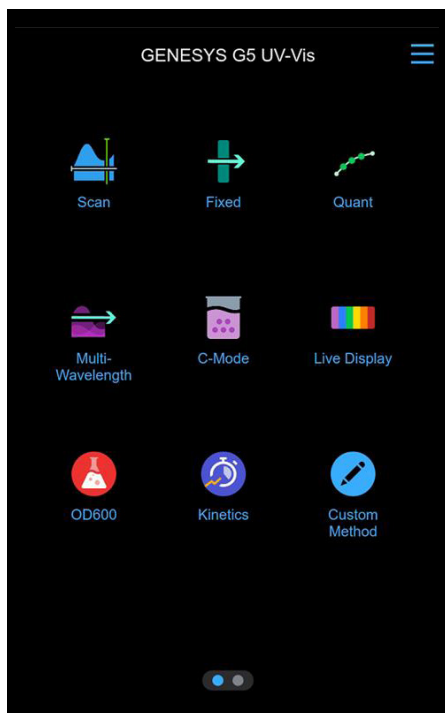


Figure 1. GENESYS Instrument screen.

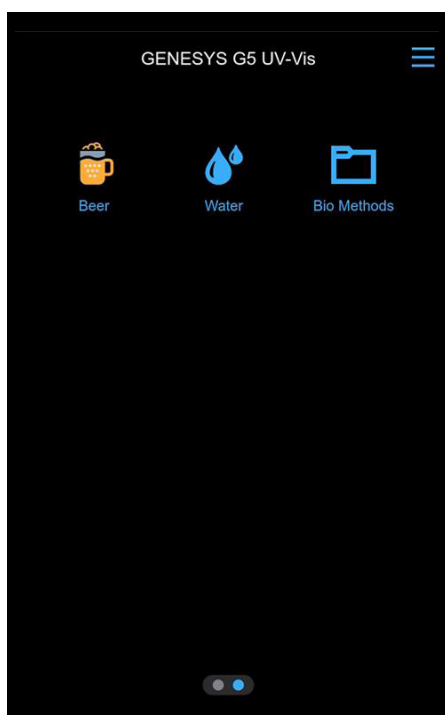


Figure 2. GENESYS Instrument screen with optional add on software.

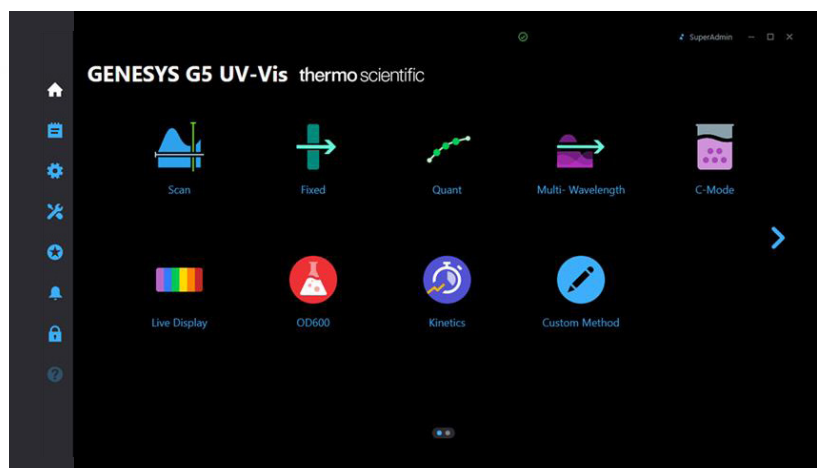


Figure 3. GENESYS PC Control screen.

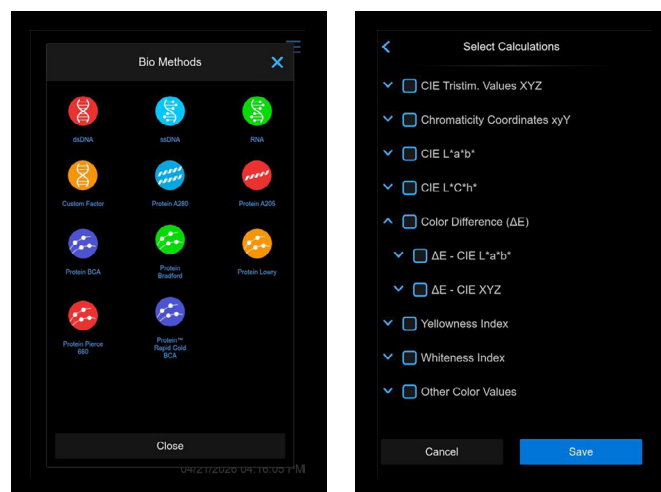


Figure 4. The GENESYS touchscreen features straightforward selection of apps and customizable methods.

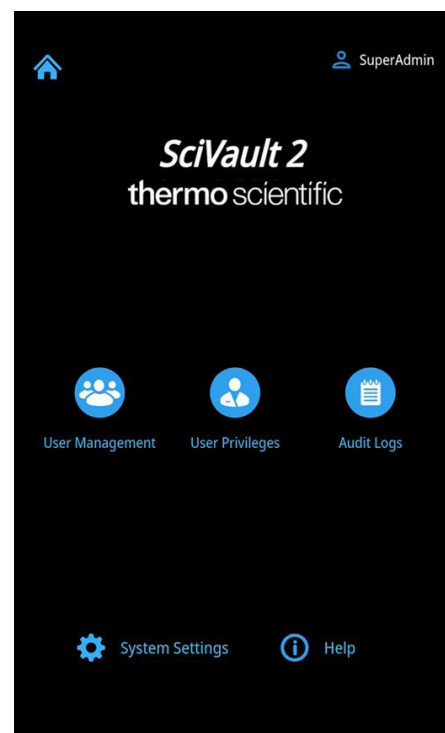


Figure 5. SciVault 2 application homescreen.

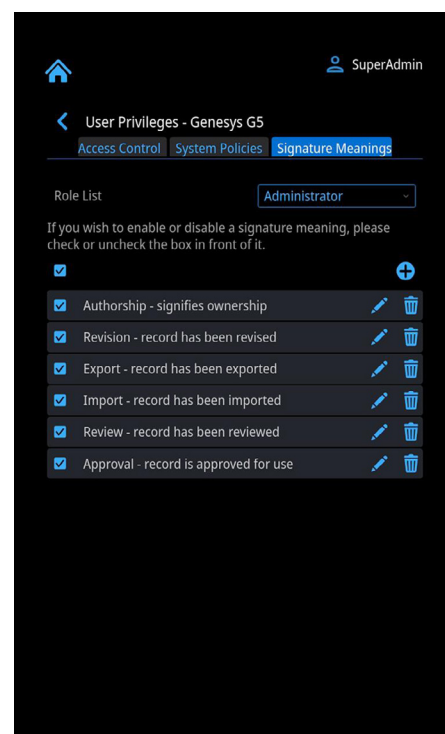


Figure 6. Signature control screen in SciVault 2.

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
